Brut Sparkling Wine

Sonoma County

TASTING NOTES

Soft in the mouth with bright notes of toasted vanilla and strawberry. The pallet has fruit on the front with a dry finish, and a nice balance of acidity.

WINE MAKERS NOTES

This bubbly is a blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, with a dash of Pinot Meunier. The Pinot brings a light note of berry, the Chardonnay sweet apple and pear with a twist of citrus. The Meunier brings it all together with structure and balance of the fruit components. Smooth fine bubbles help round out the fruit and acidity. The wine finishes long on the tongue bringing lasting fruit with a touch of lime that keeps you coming back for more.
